

How to use the flat rate time (F.R.T.)

This F.R.T. (Flat Rate Time) is used to determine the standard labor time allowed for replacement of parts covered by the warranty during the period the warranty is in effect. The F.R.T. for those parts which are not listed herein should be determined from the operation closely related to the replacement of that part.

1. The F.R.T. is based on the following servicing conditions

- A liberal allowance is added to the net servicing time.
- Standard times specified are based on the condition that the necessary servicing tools listed in the service manual (motorcycle) which describes the HONDA service policy are available close at hand and the work performed by a mechanic with normal skill.
- Time required for inspection and operational test following the servicing is included in the F.R.T.

2. Method of computing

The job times are listed in tenth of an hour to simplify computation.

(Example)

$$0.3 = 18 \text{ minutes}$$

$$5.6 = 5 \text{ hours and } 36 \text{ minutes}$$
